LOCATION OF THE GUN CLUB

From The East:

Exit 64 from I-84 at Black's Creek-Kuna Exit and travel west on Kuna-Mora Road for 6 miles or exit on the Gowen Road Exit and travel Gowen Road west for 3 miles, then go south on Pleasant Valley Road for 6 miles to Kuna-Mora Road then east 1 mile.

From The West:

From I-84 take Orchard (#52) exit. Go south on Orchard. Orchard Street merges with Gowen Road & turns south-east. Follow traffic along Gowen Road approximately 1/4 mile to Pleasant Valley Road. Turn south on Pleasant Valley Road for approximately 6 miles to Kuna-Mora Road. (You will pass the Idaho State prison). At the intersection of Pleasant Valley and Kuna-Mora Road, turn east on Kuna-Mora Road. The club is on the north side of the road approximately 3/4 of a mile east of the intersection.

ANNUAL STATE MEETING

The Annual Meeting this year will be split into two (2) sessions. The first session will be held on Sunday, May 27, 2012 between Event 7 and Event 8 (approximately 12 noon). This session will include the giving out of the State Teams awards, Average Leaders awards, the inductions of our new Hall of Fame members, and the election of Delegates.

The second session will be held on Sunday, May 27, 2012 at the conclusion of this day's shooting. This session will be for general business and election of Directors.

Reminder: Members MUST have a Current (paper) ATA Average Card to be eligible to vote!

Program Info:

The results of the survey that was sent to all of the active Idaho Registered Shoot Clubs will be discussed. Based on the results of the survey the Board has agreed that shooters shall be offered two (2) choices for future Idaho State shoots.

Option #1 - Keep the same dates that we have now, 4 day shoot, Friday, Saturday, Sunday, and Monday (Monday always being Memorial Day).

Option #2 - Date would be Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday (Saturday and Sunday being the first full weekend in July).

Certification

THIS CERTIFIES THE I.S.T.A. has been authorized to hold a registered shoot at Kuna, Idaho on
May 25, 26, 27, 28, 2012

The 2012 ATA Rules will govern this shoot, and the scores will be included in the official records.

NOTICE

LADY I, LADY II, JUNIOR GOLD, & SUB. VETERAN

For those of you that are entering in any of the above categories, and will be shooting for ALL AMERICAN POINTS. Not all Events will have Trophies for these new Categories, but ALL AMERICAN POINTS PINS will be available. Should you qualify for a Points Pin see Danny McKenzie or Bruce Baumgartner.

Ladies, there will be a Ladies Trophy in each event. Even if you did not win this Trophy, you may have qualified for a Points Pin in one or the other Lady I/Lady II Category.

In the Championship Singles (Events 5 & 7) Trophies in all four of the new categories will be provided by the ATA.

NOTICE OF TAXATION

The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) requires that anyone making \$600 or more at a shoot, that these monies must be reported to the IRS by the shoot host.

In order for the Shoot Host to do this required reporting, we MUST have the Social Security Number (SS#) or Tax ID number of the Shooters that win \$600 or more. This is accomplished by completing an IRS Form W9.

So if you think you may have \$600 or more in winnings, make sure to complete a W9 form and return it to Jim Nelson or the Cashier's Desk prior to leaving the Shoot. Shooters that win \$600 or more and have not completed the W9 Form will have the form mailed to them, but the State Association will NOT mail their winnings until the form is returned.

REGISTRATION

Registration begins at 1:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m. May 24, 2012.

1. Take your ATA card with proof of current year's paid membership dues to the handicap table. Have your plastic card ready, with all averages up to date, including a doubles average. No averages - AA 27-yards-AA Doubles.
2. Go to squadding window.
3. Select events, purses and options prior to arriving at the cashiering windows.
4. Take all forms to the cashiering window Make all checks payable to the Idaho State Trapshooting Associations (ISTA).

*Any shooter who wishes
to squad another shooter
must have that shooter's ATA plastic card
and Handicap card with up-to-date averages.*

HOA and All-Around score will be computed by the cashier and posted following Event #9. Shooters will be responsible for checking these sheets for errors and notifying the scoreboard personnel. The 16-yard classification of a shooter in Event #1 will be used to determine HOA Classification.

Shoot Rules and Information

LADIES, JUNIORS, SUB-JUNIORS, VETERANS, SENIOR VETERANS & ROOKIES

It is your responsibility to notify the handicap committee of your special classification.

PITA SHOOTERS

If you have a PITA card, it is your responsibility to present it at the handicap table.

ADVANCE SQUADDING

This is encouraged, but you must have ATA number, yardage, and complete name and address on your presquadding form.

PRE-SQUADDERS UPON ARRIVING AT THE SHOOT:

1. Go to the handicap table to pick up your entry form and be classified.
2. Go directly to cashier to pay entry - squad and post will already be marked on entry form.

SCORERS & SCORING

Your score will be called at the end of each 5 shots, 10 for Doubles. It is the duty of the contestant to have any error corrected before he/she has fired the first shot at the succeeding position or in the case of his last post before he/she leaves the trap.

TARGET SETTING

Target setting will be under the direction of the ISTA. No targets will be changed without permission from an ISTA Director.

REFUNDS

No entry fees, purses or options will be refunded after the event has started. All refunds will be mailed to the shooters with the payoffs. NO CASH REFUNDS.

GRIEVANCE COMMITTEE

ISTA Directors & State Delegate.

LATE SHOOTERS

Watch your squad number No shooter will be called on the speaker. Shooters missing their squad will be resquadded only if they pay a \$10.00 resquadding fee. There will be NO Waiting period.

MONEY DIVISION

All purses and added money divided High Gun System unless noted. All options divided percentage system.

Shoot Rules and Information

STATE TEAM RACE

Must consist of one AA, one A, one B, one C, and one D shooter. A lower class shooter can move up classes. Team must enter before first half of singles race starts. One Team per club.

SHOOTOFFS

A shootoff committee of the ISTA Directors and State Delegate will conduct all shootoffs. See them for any information concerning shootoffs. All shootoffs will be held immediately following the conclusion of each day's events. **YOU MUST BE PRESENT WHEN CALLED OR FORFEIT.**

TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded following the shootoffs, each day.

100 STRAIGHTS

The ISTA has 100 and 200 straight pins available. If you qualify please see Jim Nelson.

PAYOFF

All payoffs will be posted as soon as possible following the event. All shooters will receive a payoff sheet following the shoot. Payoffs will be made by check only and mailed to shooters.

SPECIAL EVENT

The Boise Gun Club Social Hour will be Sunday evening. During this activity we will Auction the Special event Shooters.

ATA POINTS

ATA points will be available at this shoot.

Classification

PENALTY YARDAGE AND CLASSIFICATION

The handicap committee may assign a MINIMUM of 24 yards and Class A Singles and Class A Doubles to any shooter who does not have an established shooting history or the shooter may shoot for targets and trophies only. Any shooting history may be used to establish classification and yardage for shooting targets and trophies only. In all cases, known ability will have a strong bearing on classification. A shooter belonging to another shooting association will be required to shoot from his or her longest yardage.

Hall of Fame Inductee - John Keppinger



John was first introduced to trapshooting in 1956 at the age of ten years old by his father. The Indian Valley Gun Club, Indian Valley was their trapshooting home. He was hooked on the sport and started shooting registered birds in the late 60's. During his younger years John worked the farm his grandfather homesteaded in 1903. The farm produced hay, wheat, and cattle. During the continuous improvements of the farm, John built 40 wildlife ponds and planted over 20,000 trees for the area's wildlife. John sold the farm in 1995 and moved to Ontario, Oregon to become manager for Heinz foods in the potato storage services division. He and his wife Helen moved to Meridian, Idaho in 2009 to be closer to their grandchildren. He and Helen just celebrated their 32nd anniversary. What makes the year 2011 so special was they won the husband and wife singles title at the Camas Prairie shoot in Walla Walla, Washington.

- Oregon State Shoot, Doubles A Champion 2009

During John's years of shooting he has registered over 80 one hundred straights with the first 100 shot at Lewiston, Idaho in 1971. Due to an accident on his farm, there were many years John was unable to shoot any trap. John's persistence and dedication to trapshooting kept him going. Trying lighter loads, low recoiling guns, and equipment to make shooting easier, he has found a way to remain competitive. His wife Helen is a huge supporter of his and you will find them traveling together to trapshoots throughout the western states.

John is currently the President of the Boise Gun Club. He is past president of the Weiser Trap Club (1970), Council Trap Club (1975), and the past President and Treasurer of the Indian Valley Trap Club (1978-1992).

John has a granddaughter, Shelby Birr, who shoots regularly at registered events. John not only supports her shooting but, being the current President of the Boise Gun Club, he spends a great deal of time and energy constantly improving the club for all the shooters whether practice, league, or registered shoots.

John's legacy will surely be the love of trapshooting and the people involved. You can always ask him for help or suggestions to improve the club or your shooting. He is always available. Helen and John have shot at over 35 gun clubs and have met and become friends with shooters throughout the Pacific Northwest. Say hello to John. He is a huge asset to our sport whether shooting or helping the club.
